

**Subject: Creation of Endowment Chair and Scholarships to the Undergraduate students**


Dear Sir,

Kindly refer to your letter No.IT/D-09(a)/227 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2007 on the above mentioned subject. Your proposal was examined by the Empowered Committee in its meeting held on 14.8.2007. In this meeting it was decided to create one Endowment Chair for a Professor of Metallurgy in your institute. The salary of the Professor of Metallurgy will be at par with your institute's norms in respect of the Chair Professors. It was also decided to give five scholarships @ Rs.4000 per month to the under graduate students. The EC further decided that the following guidelines would be followed in this regard:

- i) The selection for the endowment chair and scholarships will be as per the procedure duly laid down by the concerned institute.
- ii) Scholarships will be given for the entire 4 years to the academically bright students of a batch who agree to provide an undertaking to pursue their career in ferrous metallurgy
